This includes monthly meetings of the whole Committee lasting about 2 hours, meetings every 1-2 months of working groups (each Committee member typically sits on one or two working groups) and email correspondence between meetings. Members may also volunteer in activities on the Common, such as assisting with Bandstand concerts or community gardening.
